

■ MANUFACTURE ■

This Reference Product comes from sites that have received ISO14001 certification.



■ DISTRIBUTION **■**

Products are distributed from logistics centres located with a view to optimize transport efficiency. The Reference Product is therefore transported over an average distance of 780 km by road from our warehouse to the local point of distribution into the European market. Packaging is compliant with European directive 2004/12/EU concerning packaging and packaging waste. At their end of life, its recyclability rate is 67 % (in % of packaging weight).



INSTALLATION

For the installation of the product, considering the wide range of possible installation of communication and data wires and cables, the impact concerning the product installation processes should be completed by the PEP user.

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■ END OF LIFE ■

The product end-of-life factors are taken into account during the design phase. Dismantling and sorting of components or materials is made as easy as possible with a view to recycling or failing that, another form of reuse.

• Recyclability rate:

Calculated using the method described in technical report IEC/TR 62635, the recyclability rate of the product is estimated at 95 %. This value is based on data collected from a technological channel operating on an industrial basis. It does not pre-validate the effective use of this channel for the end of life of this product.
