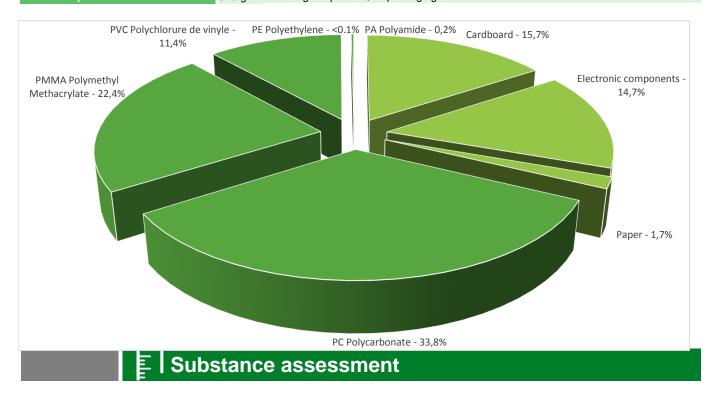
Functional unit

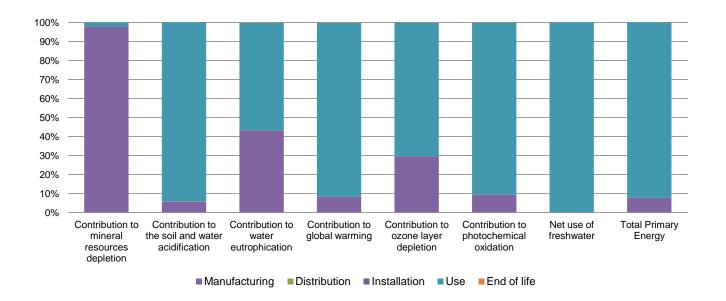
